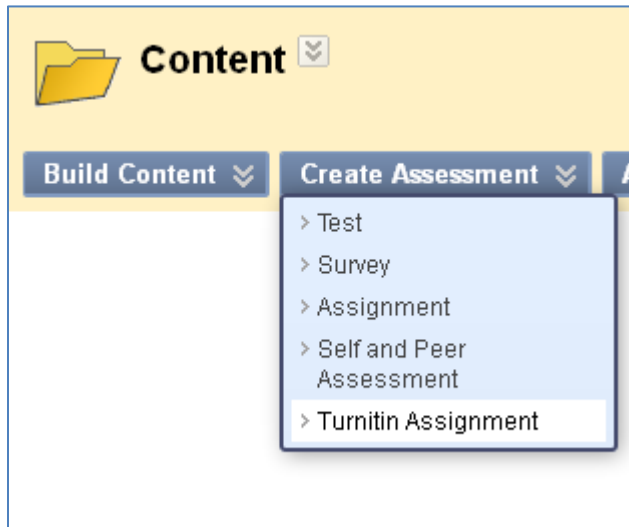


How To Create A Turnitin Assignment

1. Navigate to the content area where you wish to put the Turnitin Assignment



2. Agree to the User Agreement

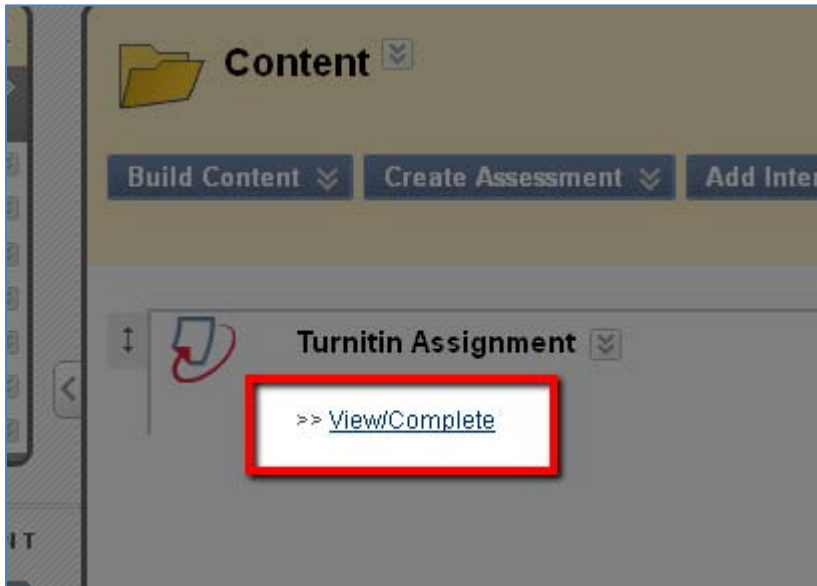

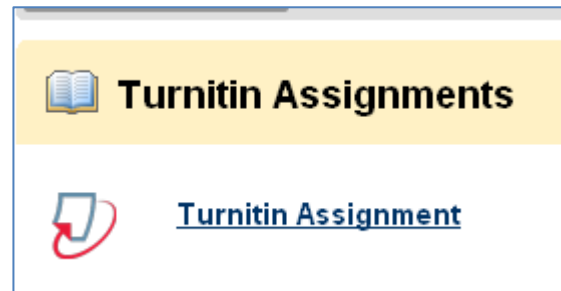
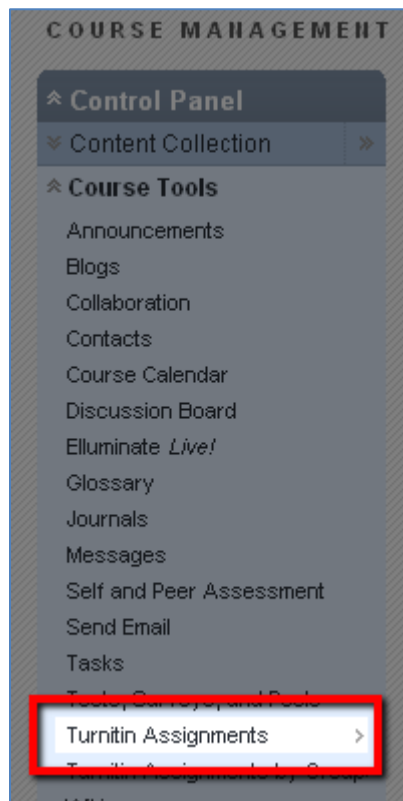

6. You will now see the Turnitin Assignment in your content area

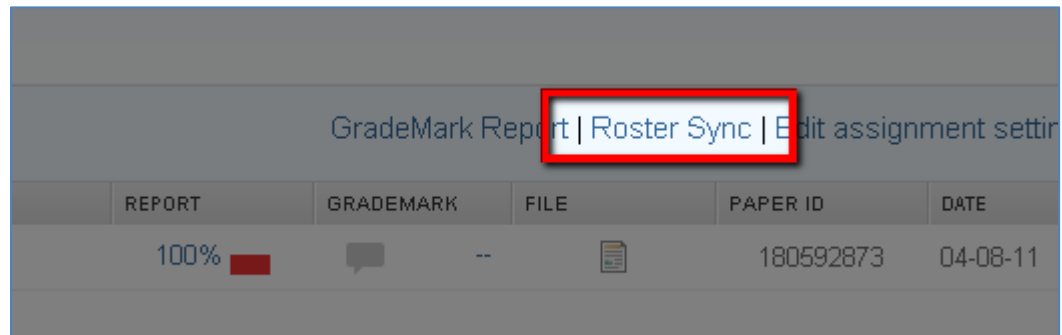


7. Once the assignment has been created, activate the Roster Sync by going into the Turnitin inbox and clicking on the link.

- a) In the Control Panel, click on Course Tools > Turnitin Assignments; click again on the Turnitin Assignment link



b) Select "Roster Sync."
